Overall Job Purpose

Provide strategic and technical leadership in the Bulk Unit to ensure provision of high quality water and sewerage services to customers by ensuring compliance with engineering and water quality standards and procedures.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Planning for long-term and short-term programs in water supply and sewerage systems including feasibility studies;
- 2. Overall responsibility of projects including planning and design of water supply and sewerage systems and other relevant engineering projects;
- 3. Provide strategic and technical leadership in the Bulk Unit to ensure provision of high quality services to customers that meet industry standards;
- 4. Steer the development of departmental policies, procedures and action plans in line with Agency's mission and objectives;
- 5. Manpower planning for the Bulk Unit; making recommendations for recruitment, redeployment and promotion;
- 6. Ensure that all water and sewerage services infrastructure is operated and maintained to the required standards.
